Dinner is provided daily for all Club by the **CUSD Nutrition**.

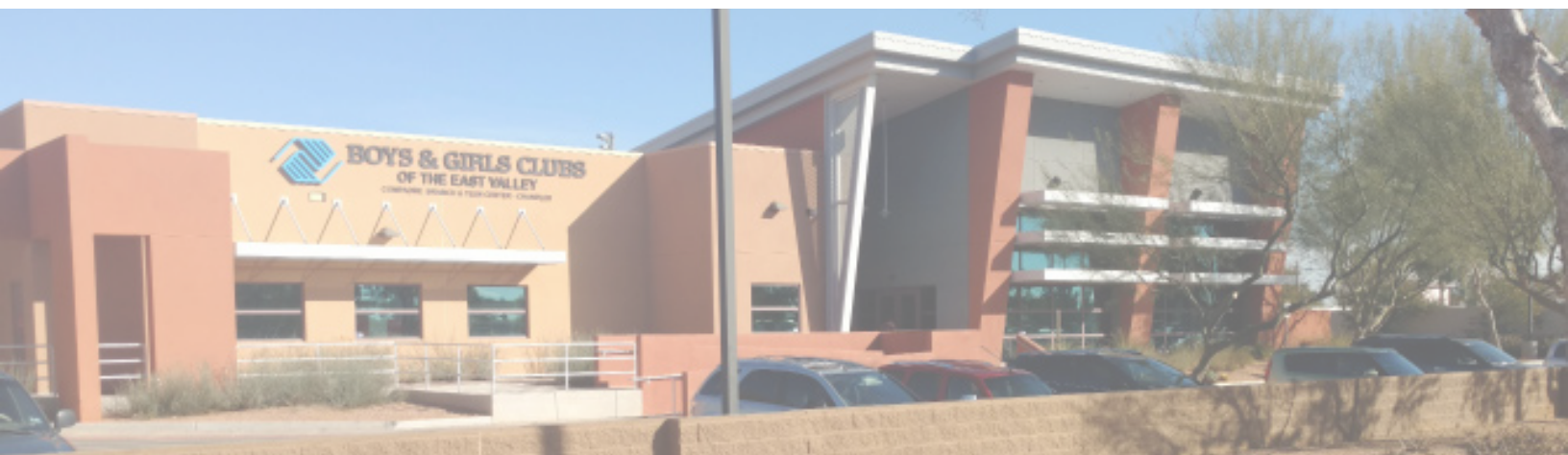
